### 5181 Asset Working Group Update

**NT** gave feedback on recent discussions in the working group. It was agreed that the following be endorsed by members before directing the HM to implement.

- 1.A dropped kerb, clearance of the facility, weed mat, Mot type1 surface, signage and access method.
- 2. The understanding that the facility be used for Marine related storage.
- 3.A charging system based on frequency of use and accessibility is used, say £600 regular use, £500 occasional access.
- 4.It should be used this season.
- 5. The use of additional equipment such as racking, or a container would be considered, but this would be dependent on demand.

There were wide ranging discussions on the subject, but members were content with the suggestions and would see how things developed over the next two years before being

more definitive.

6. It should be referred to as 'Waterside Boat Park'.
